

International Patient Decision Aid Standards (IPDAS) Collaboration

IPDAS Steering Committee Terms of Reference

1. Purpose:

To enhance the quality and effectiveness of patient decision aids by establishing a shared evidence-informed framework for improving their content, development, implementation, and evaluation.

2. Functions:

- 2.1 To oversee the processes of maintaining and revising the IPDAS criteria for improving quality and effectiveness of patient decision aids through evidence reviews.
- 2.2 To provide guidance to enhance the reporting of research on patient decision aids
- 2.3 To facilitate stakeholder involvement in IPDAS. Stakeholders include patients/public, policy makers, decision aid developers, clinicians, and researchers.
- 2.4 To disseminate and implement IPDAS criteria through overseeing and setting principles for:
 - 2.4.1 use and refinement of the IPDASi instrument and its linkage to IPDAS criteria
 - 2.4.2 production of quality-assured IPDAS training materials for use in education events (e.g. workshops, courses, online)
- 2.5 To monitor progress of the IPDAS working groups. More specifically to provide advice and share knowledge that could inform the progress of the working groups.
- 2.6 To approve consensus statements and publication of IPDAS.

3. Membership: will aim to have representation from:

- across countries; and
- multi-stakeholders, including potential end-users of IPDAS (e.g. patients/public, policy makers, decision aid developers, clinicians, and researchers).

4. Meetings:

4.1 Meetings will be held regularly (e.g. every 3 to 4 months) as determined by the group or the chairs

5. Working Groups

- 5.1 Working groups will be assigned to specific activities as needed.
- 5.2 All working groups report to the Steering Committee in advance of Steering Committee meetings (or more frequently as determined by the pace of the work).
