

## Background




- Since 1995, Ottawa Decision Support Framework (ODSF) has been used to:
  - assess patients' decisional needs
  - translate evidence to support patient decision making (e.g. patient decision aids)
  - measure changes in patient outcomes (e.g. decisional conflict scale)
  - train healthcare professionals
- Need to synthesize research and related tools based on ODSF and establish research priorities


